

# Get CERT Trained this April!



This 3-day course will cover: Personal preparedness, medical operations, fire suppression, search and rescue, and CERT organization. The most important thing you can do in a disaster is take care of yourself and your loved ones- this class will help with that, and go one step further. Once you and those you care about are safe and well, you can use your skills as a CERT to help your community in emergency response. The cost is \$50 and includes a backpack, goggles, helmet and an identification card upon completion. There are scholarships available to cover the course fee.
